

大阪経済法科大学における国際共修に関する基本方針

大阪経済法科大学の建学の理念の一つである「教育研究を通じて人権の伸長と国際平和に貢献すること」は、本学の教育活動すべてに通底する根本的な価値観であり、グローバル化が進む現代社会においてますますその意義は増しています。

本学は、この理念に基づくこれまでの教育実践を踏まえて、「国際共修」を全学的な教育の基本方針として位置づけます。本学における国際共修は、出身国・地域、言語、宗教など多様な文化的及び社会的背景を持つ学生が、各学部・研究科の専門分野を修める過程やその他学生生活における諸活動において、互いの理解に努め、個々の差異を尊重し、共に学び合う具体的な学習活動です。その目的は以下のとおりです。

- ・知識と視野を広げる中で、自己を相対化し、既存の価値観を再構成しながら、自身の可能性や能力をあらためて肯定し、内面的成長を遂げること。
- ・豊かな国際感覚を持ち、多文化社会における共生の知恵、倫理観を培い、あらゆる障壁を越えた協働の力を身に付けること。
- ・グローバル化する現代社会の諸課題に対応でき、持続可能な未来の発展を共創できる力を育むこと。

本学が推進する国際共修は、日々の教育実践の中で、人権の伸長と国際平和への貢献という建学の理念を生きたかたちで実現していく営みです。そしてそれは、留学生の受入れと派遣、外国語教育などの一部の授業やプログラムにおける教育技法にとどまらず、全学的に貫かれるべき教育の基本理念です。

Basic Policy on International Collaborative Learning

at Osaka University of Economics and Law

One of the founding principles of Osaka University of Economics and Law is that of contributing to the promotion of human rights and international peace through education and research, and this is a fundamental value underlying all our educational activities. In the context of a globalized modern society, this principle continues to grow in significance.

Building upon the educational practices rooted in this principle, the university places International Collaborative Learning (ICL) as a fundamental educational policy across the entire institution. At our university, International Collaborative Learning involves students from diverse cultural and social backgrounds, from different countries or regions, and with different languages and religions, and engages them in mutual understanding and respecting individual differences, learning together through their academic programs and other student activities. The goals of this learning are as follows:

- Students will expand their knowledge and perspectives, contextualizing their experience and reassessing their values, to affirm their potential and abilities, and achieve personal growth.
- Students will cultivate a rich sense of international awareness, develop wisdom and ethics for coexistence in a multicultural society, and acquire the ability to collaborate across all barriers.
- Students will foster an ability to address global challenges and contribute to creating a sustainable future.

The International Collaborative Learning promoted by this university is a practice that realizes our founding principle of promoting human rights and contributing to international peace in the form of our daily educational activities. This approach is not limited to specific courses or programs, such as those involving international students or foreign language education, but represents a basic educational philosophy that is to be applied across the entire university.
