Course Load	Exchange students are expected to register for a minimum of 14 OUEL credits and no more than 26 OUEL credits per semeste during their exchange period at OUEL. Students are also advised to check with their home university regarding the requirements on course load while studying abroad.						
Academic Transcript	An original academic transcript will be mailed to the home university within 2 months after the semester ends.
